BASIC ORDER OF STEPS FOR LONG EXPOSURE CAPTURE

The steps below need to be followed in rough order:

- 1. Find a rough composition hand-held
- 2. Set-up on tripod and lock-down the above composition
- 3. Dial-in focus and exposure WITHOUT filters
- 4. Capture normal-exposure image (for use in #5 & #6 below)
- 5. Check histogram for proper exposure
- 6. Check image preview for CRITICAL focus (using loupe if available)
- 7. Put shutter speed dial on 'BULB' or 'TIME' mode
- 8. Make sure ISO and F-Stop are the same as they were on the normal exposure
- 9. Determine adjusted exposure time for the ND filter being used
- 10. Put filter(s) on, being careful not to bump focus ring
- 11. Turn OFF auto-focus (unless you are using the 'back button focus' method)
- 12. Set timing device for adjusted exposure time
- 13. Cover viewfinder with tape, towel, hat, etc.
- 14. Cover camera with towel (if needed)
- 15. THEN... start the exposure and the timing device
- 16. Skip some rocks, check email, or plan your next composition while you wait
- 17. Stop the exposure at the appropriate time
- 18. Verify proper exposure and CRITICAL focus before relocating the camera
- 19. If needed, make focus and/or exposure adjustments for another capture
- 20. Congratulations... you have successfully made a long exposure capture!!!
